The Problem of Sidelines

How will investors deploy their \$6 trillion?

- They buy stocks from investors who currently own them...
- Buying of \$6 tn. sideline-deploying investors requires... ...selling of \$6 tn. sideline-creating investors.

A bit more theoretical

- Fundamental principle of markets: every buyer needs a seller!
- Transactions only re-distribute cash and securities but don't create them.
- Equilibrium: "Add us all up and there are no sidelines." (Asness, 2014, p.25)

More Ideas about Sidelines

IPOs and delistings

- Investors can enter stock market via IPO without someone else exiting...
- But every buyer still needs a seller!
- Cash flows from sideline-deploying investor to sideline-creating IPO owner.

Investor-specific sidelines

- Can still analyze cash-holdings of single investors or groups!
- Example: Cash allocation of fund managers in BofA Fund Manager Survey.
- Question: Are those investors better at timing than others?



- > The narrative of *Cash on the Sidelines* is intuitive but misleading.
- The simple market-equilibrium concept destroys the narrative.
- Cash holdings of *single* investors may still be useful indicators.
- Why does it exist? Easier to think in non-equilibrium way (Kahneman, 2011)...
